The remarks of Mr. Lee took the form of a prophecy. He invited the friends present to attend the celebration when another fifty years had rolled around, and told what they might expect to find in the way of buildings. In the course of his remarks he took occasion to announce the gift of five hundred dollars to the school from the Jubilee Class, to be used in furnishing the reception room in the new dormitory building, the room to be known as Jubilee Hall.
